**Invitation for Tenders**

1. This invitation for tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which appeared in the United Nations Development Business Issued No 0P00039403 of October 6<sup>th</sup> 2016.
2. The Prime Minister's Office has received a loan from the World Bank to meet cost of the Southern Agriculture Growth Corridor of Tanzania (SAGCOT) and intends to apply part of the proceeds to eligible payments under the contract for supply of motor vehicles for SAGCOT – SIP.
3. The Prime Minister's Office (Policy, Coordination and Parliament) now invites sealed tenders from eligible Suppliers of motor vehicles.
4. Tendering will be conducted through the national competitive tendering method procedures specified in the Public Procurement Regulations, 2013 – Government Notice No. 446 as amended in 2016, and is open to all tenderers as defined in the Regulations
5. Interested eligible tenderers may obtain further information from and inspect the tendering documents at the office of the Secretary of the Tender Board, Prime Minister's Office (Policy, Coordination and Parliament)
6. A complete set of tendering document(s) in English and additional sets may be purchased by interested tenderers on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 5 above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of TZS 100,000.00 (Tanzania Shilling one hundred thousands only). Payment should either

be by cash, banker's draft, or banker's cheque, payable to Permanent Secretary, Prime Minister's Office (Policy, Coordination and Parliament).

7. All tenders must be accompanied by a bid securing declaration in the format provided in the tendering documents.
8. All tenders in one (01) original plus two (02) copies, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelope must be delivered to the Office of the Director of Procurement Management Unit, Prime Minister's Office, 2 Railway Street, P.O. Box 980, 40480 Dodoma, Room No. 29 at or before Thursday, 14<sup>TH</sup> November, 2018 at 12:00 hours local time. Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of tenderers' representatives who choose to attend the opening at the Conference Room, Prime Minister's Office, Dodoma.
9. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, tenders not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
